Lost and found

Policy:

The SAPC and it's designated captains are not responsible for lost or found property at venues. SAPC does not have a lost-and-found repository or retrieval system. Any items found at a venue will be left at the venue

Individual members may take care of identifiable items of fellow members on their own, providing that this member will contact the owner and hand over the item promptly.

Purpose:

To have a consistent and workable approach to lost and found items at our many venues.

Clarification:

Due to the large number of venues and even greater number of Captains, this approach is at present the best option for SAPC.

To clarify, the Captain is **not** responsible to hold on to, or take care of, items left behind after a session.

Items found at Alpine courts may be turned over to the City of St Albert Lost and Found department.

Items found at churches or schools may be deposited in their Lost and Found bins.
